Immaculee Ilibagiza at the Tabernacle August 28th!

Thanks to the generosity of the Camp Meeting Association, our Vineyard non-profit organization is underway to bring Immaculée Ilibagiza to the Tabernacle this summer, on Saturday evening, August 28th at 7:00 pm.


Immaculée normally charges \$15,000 for her honorarium plus \$900 travel expenses from New York, plus hotel, and meal costs for herself and her TA (travel assistant). Because of COVID we are having an open event (no curtains) and no ticket sales, just a free-will offering and we are negotiating a reduced speaker's fee. We hope to raise the funds to underwrite the honorarium and other expenses (printing of a program, posters, advertisement, etc.) through donations from individuals, businesses, organizations, churches, etc. with a sponsorship program:

Friends: under \$99; **Benefactors:** \$100 - \$299; **Angels:** \$300 - \$499; **Guardians Angels:** \$500 - \$999; **Archangels:** \$1,000 and over!
