This from Henri Nouwen's "A Spirituality of Fundraising":

"In fundraising as a ministry, we are inviting people into a new way of relating to their resources. By giving people a spiritual vision, we want them to experience that they will in fact benefit by making their resources available to us. We truly believe that if their gift is good only for us who receive, it is not fundraising in the spiritual sense.

"Fundraising from the point of view of the gospel says to people 'I will take your money and invest it in this vision only if it is good for your spiritual journey, only if it is good for your spiritual health.'

"In other words, we are calling to an experience of conversion: 'You won't become poorer, you will become richer by giving.' We can confidently declare with the apostle Paul: 'You will be enriched in every way for your great generosity.' (2 Cor. 9:11).
